But Facebook has been keeping track of practically everything you've ever done on their site -- and lots of other sites -- and will only share some of that with you. Now they support allowing the government broad access to your records. Meanwhile, a national survey by Consumer Reports projected that nearly 13 million U.S. Facebook users have never set privacy controls - an essential step in using the biggest social network safely. Facebook should think twice about how it shares your private information...and so should you.

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
