WHAT: Approved last week by Congress, the new prescription drug benefit will have a huge and lasting impact on the nation's growing senior population. But it is a complicated package that is causing confusion, uncertainty—even panic—among many Medicare beneficiaries. Ms. Lieberman can answer:

- What choices do seniors need to make in January 2004—just a few weeks away?
- Should you choose to stay with a Medigap policy or switch to an HMO?
- What are the tradeoffs between these two options?
- How can seniors decide whether to purchase the drug discount card, which will become available next year—and what are the tradeoffs?
- What other choices will Medicare beneficiaries need to make—and how to decide among them—when other new benefits kick-in in 2006?
