Under a law called the Global Warming Solutions Act (AB 32), California has taken practical steps to reduce greenhouse gases, improve public health, and deliver cleaner fuels—all while our economy continues to grow. But right now the law is under attack.

More efficient vehicles are already cutting consumers' fuel bills, and even more dramatic savings are just down the road. On average, Californians will pay **30% LESS** in fuel bills by 2020 versus just three years ago. Big savings on fuel adds up to millions of dollars businesses and families can spend elsewhere in the economy.



**CLEANER CARS
AND TRUCKS**

Transportation is the largest source of pollution in California, contributing 40% of the state's carbon pollution. AB 32 is slashing pollution so that our air will be safer to breathe.

Attacks from Big Oil
